

Assignment /webdev: Individual Project

This project is an individual project which involves an interactive web environment. This project should NOT be commercial in nature, but rather explore your creative expression. You will propose, plan, create, and present this personal creative project as your final project.

The Proposal

Project planning is significant to each project and is allocated a separate grade. Each project must be presented in proposal form as an idea first before implementation.

Write a short proposal and post it on the web to present in class. It will end up being about 5 pages in length. The proposal must accurately describe your idea. For example, let's say you are doing an interactive sound piece, and you find it difficult to describe as far as narrative is concerned. In this case, describe your formal approach, the reasoning behind different sound juxtapositions, etc. Remember, even if you do a straightforward narrative, you must justify why the format is interactive. In other words, the form should equal the function and purpose of the work. Use diagrams and drawings to help convey your idea.

Each planning document must be posted on the web and include the following:

- Title, Collaborators
- Abstract (100 words)A one-page artist statement
- Description of project (1 page) which is a summary of the proposed work, its significance, its uniqueness with any references conforming to MLA or Chicago standards
- A diagram of the interface and architecture the work will utilize
- Timeline (1/2 page, in table)
- A proposed budget for the work (1/2 page, in table)
- A list of possible venues for the work (web, gallery, conference, rave, etc) and a plan of submitting the work to such venues.

The Project

The project could take the form of an interactive narrative, an experiment, an online interactive sculpture, online performance -- whichever your idea, it must be rigorously thought out, and you need to be open to feedback.
